What have I been doing since high school?

In the fall of 1969 I attended Lee College in Baytown, Texas and continued in the spring of 1970. During that period I ran the roads in my Goat (1966 Pontiac GTO) with my best friend, like a brother, Kenny McAfee. Those were the days you could drive around all night on two dollars worth of gas. Well our fun soon ended when Uncle Sam drew number seven as my draft number (draft birthday lottery). I decided Viet Nam was not the place for me so I made the choice to see the world and sail the seven seas. I would soon learn that I had made the correct decision.

In November of 1970 I was off to Orlando, FL. for Naval basic training, not so bad, even attended the Tangerine Football Bowl Game. Then it was off to school in San Diego, CA for four months Naval training. School and California were even better and I managed to graduate in the top of my class which must have caught some ones attention for I was the only one in my class with orders overseas. In June 1971 I reported aboard the USS Springfield CLG-7 Flag Ship of the Sixth Fleet stationed in Gaeta, Italy. Gaeta was located about an hour train ride from Rome. In the two years I was aboard the Springfield we made multiple swings/cruises to ports in Italy, France, Spain, Portugal, Greece, Turkey, Tunis, and Morocco not to mention various Islands in the Mediterranean. I had bonfires larger than the one at our Channelview High School Homecoming.

I work at a manufacturing facility which supplies machined components to original equipment manufacturers throughout the United States. My current duties include manufacturing engineering, plant management, and sales engineering. Other duties include entertaining customer on the company fifty foot sailboat and guiding coastal fishing trips. If you have not guessed who I am by now maybe this will give you a hint.
